The B.C. Utilities Commission (BCUC) has approved interim rate increases to PNG's gas delivery rates and permanent decreases to PNG's gas commodity rates effective January 1, 2012. Overall rates are decreasing by \$0.201 per GJ for residential customers and by \$0.290 per GJ for small commercial customers.

Compared to current rates, the decrease for a residential customer with an annual consumption of 75 GJ will be about \$15 per year, at 100 GJ the decrease would be \$20 per year, and at 200 GJ, \$40 per year. The decrease for a small commercial customer with an annual consumption of 300 GJ will be about \$87 per year, and at 400 GJ the decrease would be \$116 per year.

If the BCUC decides to reduce the interim rates after reviewing PNG's 2012 rate application, you will receive a refund with interest in a future bill. Please visit the Company's website at www.png.ca for further information on rates or call the number on your bill statement.
